In 1H we will be inquirers by asking questions. We will research information to seek answers.

In 1H we will be principled by always showing whole body listening, being honest and respecting everybody.

In 1H we will be open-minded by always trying our best and taking on feedback to improve our learning. We will respect everyone's ideas, culture and religion.

In 1H we will be good communicators by sharing our ideas, listening to other's and their ideas. We will always use kind words to each other.

In 1H we will be balanced by eating a range of food in our lunch boxes and drinking lots of water. We will be open to play with different people.

In 1H we will be reflective by understanding what our strengths are and areas we need to improve on. We will use feedback to improve our work and meet our goals.

2A

In 2A we will show we are THINKERS by finding new ways to problem-solve. We complete our work to the best of our abilities. We use anchor charts, materials and feedback to solve problems.

In 2A we show we are PRINCIPLED by respecting ourselves and others. We listen to others who are talking with our eyes and ears. We keep our hands, feet and objects to ourselves. We listen to instructions and let everyone work without distraction. We are honest. We follow our Essential Agreement expectations, because we believe it will make our classroom a happy and safe learning environment.

In 2A we are COMMUNICATORS by sharing our creative ideas clearly and confidently. We use positive body language. We write and draw neatly. We talk to others if we need help or have a problem. We use Spanish words and phrases that we have learnt. We use communication techniques we have learned through Drama, Dance and Art.

In 2A we are RISK TAKERS by stepping outside our comfort zones. We have a go at answering questions, even if we are not sure if we are right. We are not afraid to try new things, and new ways to solve problems. We try again, even if we made a mistake the first time.

In 2A we are OPEN MINDED by trying to understand other people's feelings and ideas, even if they are different from our own. We share and respect our own and other's cultures, languages and backgrounds.

In 2A we are KNOWLEDGEABLE by being confident to share our knowledge and ideas with others. We take an interest in issues that affect both our local communities (our school & our town) and the wider world (Australia and overseas). We use strategies to improve our long-term memory. We love learning!

In 2A we are BALANCED by participating in a range of activities inside and outside the classroom. We try everything, not just the things we like best. We understand that there is a time for learning and a time for play. We understand that there is a time to talk and a time to be quiet.

2B



In 2B we will be CARING by treating others how we wish to be treated. We will ask our classmates if they are okay or want to play with us. We will be respectful to each other and work together as a team. We will look out for each other in the yard. We will walk around our classroom safely.

We will be RISK TAKERS by not being afraid to try new things. We will be brave enough to put our hand up and have a go. If we make a mistake we will not give up. We will always try our best.

We will be COMMUNICATORS by talking politely and using our manners. We will share our ideas and listen to others. We will talk to others and ask for help if we need it. We will use good body language.

We will be PRINCIPLED by being honest. We will take responsibility for our actions. We will use our 5L's when sitting on the floor and put our hand up when we have a question.

We will be OPEN MINDED by accepting each other and celebrating our differences. We will be kind and accepting of everyone and respect other people's cultures and backgrounds. We will think before we speak.

We will be BALANCED by having a go at new things. We understand that there is a time for listening and learning and a time to play. We will look after ourselves and others.

We will be KNOWLEDGEABLE by having the confidence to share our ideas with each other. We will always try our best to understand new things that we are learning. We will practise our new learning at home to become better learners.

We will show that we are THINKERS by thinking of ways to solve problems. We will complete our work to the best of our abilities.

We will be REFLECTIVE by thinking about our learning. We will set goals for our learning. We will think about our behaviour and how it affects our classmates and their learning.

We will be INQUIRERS by asking for help with our learning. We will ask questions to find out more information. We will ask our friends, read books or research information we would like to learn more about. We will share that with our classmates.

2C



In 2C, we show we are caring by treating others the way we want to be treated by being 'bucket fillers'. We will ask others if they are okay, if they need a hug or if they need somebody to play with. We help take care of ourselves, each other, our belongings and the environment.

In 2C we are communicators by identifying our feelings using the zones of regulation. We communicate our ideas using facial expressions, body language, our voices and hand gestures. We talk to others when we need help or have a problem.

In 2C we are knowledgeable by being confident to share our knowledge and ideas with others. We never stop learning! We know that we may get stuck in the learning pit before we fully understand something. We are not afraid to ask knowledgeable others for more information.

In 2C we are risk takers because we THINK GREEN! We are not afraid to try new things because we know if we get stuck in the learning pit, we will have help from others. We put our hand up confidently during class discussions. WE NEVER GIVE UP! Anything is possible if you try!

In 2C we are reflective by confidently thinking about our behaviour and how it affects others. Before making a decision, we STOP, THINK about our options and DO the right thing. We are always setting goals to improve our learning.

In 2C we are inquirers by asking questions during class discussions and researching to find out more information. We remain curious by always wanting to learn more.

In 2C we show we are thinkers by finding new ways to problem-solve. We complete our work to the best of our abilities. We think green!

2D



In 2D we are learning what it means to be a RISK TAKER both within and outside the classroom. We agreed that we will always try our best in everything that we do and when we get stuck, we know it is important to keep moving forward and dive into the deep end. We will do our best to always think green when our mind is telling us red thoughts and give everything a try by saying "I CAN DO THIS!" We can brainstorm to see what worked well and what we need to change next time. We believe it is important to set goals so we know what we need to focus on and work towards. In 3A, we are thinkers. Thinking helps our minds grow! Thinking helps us learn and make good decisions. We will seek to understand problems and find solutions. As a class, we understand that the skill of critical thinking will help us all be fantastic learners!

3B

We understand communication is sharing a message and it can be verbal or non-verbal. This means our body language also sends a message, so we need to be mindful of not only words, but actions too.

In 3C, we will be *inquirers* by asking purposeful, open questions to guide our learning. Purposeful questions are questions that are specific and clear. Open questions provide us with detailed information, beneficial to our Inquiry. When we ask questions, we will put our hand up, not call out and make sure our questions are relevant.

In 3C, we will be *risk-takers* by facing our fears. We understand that we may be hesitant at first, but as risk-takers, we will build our confidence to face challenges outside our comfort zone. We will be brave and willing to make mistakes, because in 3C, mistakes are OK! We promise to follow our motto – 'You don't have to be the best; you just need to TRY your best!'

In 3C, we will be *reflective* by evaluating our strengths and weaknesses and using these to set personal learning goals. We will provide feedback to our peers when they ask, and focus on '2 stars, 1 wish' feedback.

If we break any of our Essential Agreements or are involved in an incident, we will reflect on our actions and complete a restorative reflection to ensure it doesn't happen again.

In 3D we will be open-minded students by listening to other people's ideas and learning new things. We will respect the cultures of everyone in the school community and be brave by understanding those cultures. We will take the time to speak and work with new people, because we are all equal human beings.

In 3D we will be thinkers by thinking before we act and speak, as well as thinking about other people's feelings. We will think about new ideas and solve problems by thinking clearly through them. We will remember the past to think about the future.

In 3D we will be principled people by always being honest to the teacher, our classmates and other members of the school community. We will always tell the truth and take responsibility for our actions. We will be genuine people who act on the outside as we are on the inside.

In 3D we will be inquirers by being curious learners. We will do this by asking many questions inside and outside the classroom. We will ask meaningful, relevant and appropriate questions to improve our learning. We will explain our answers and listen to other people's questions to gain a greater understanding.

In 3D we will be risk takers by always trying our best. We will always take responsible risks by being brave and trying new things. If we make a mistake we can always try again, because that is how we learn. We will support each other through any tough moments we have in life.
